In Compliance with letter No. F.No. 12(14)/Env./2023/2645-2649 , Dated 14.07.2025 received from Department of Environment, GNCT of Delhi and Circular F.No. DE.40(6)/90/SCB/2025/875-1882 ,Dated 22.07.25 , issued by Directorate of Education , Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi , Eco Club of St. Cecilia's Public School, Vikaspuri, New Delhi organised an Online Awareness Campaign in the month of August regarding Ban on Sharp Manjha/Chinese Manjha in GNCT of Delhi.

Students geared up as Eco Warriors discussed in details about the different types of Manjhas, their impact on lives of humans, animals and birds, and how as responsible citizens of the state we must completely ban the usage of the same in our lives. The students understood that merriment of the kite flying festivals need to be carefully weighed against the harmful consequences of the sharp manjha on the diverse biotic elements of our ecosystem.
