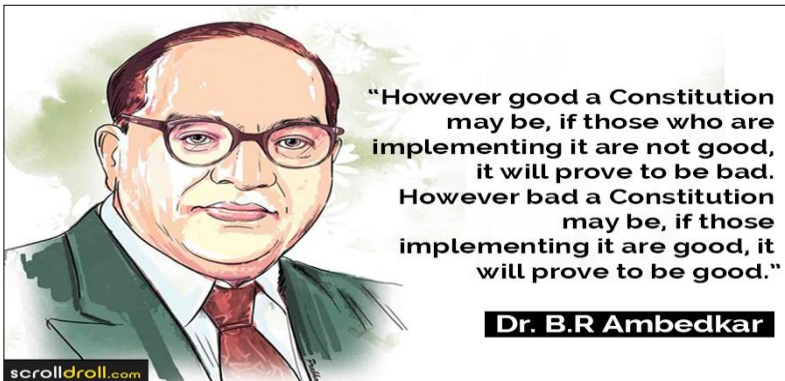


ST. CECILIA'S PUBLIC SCHOOL Constitution Day
