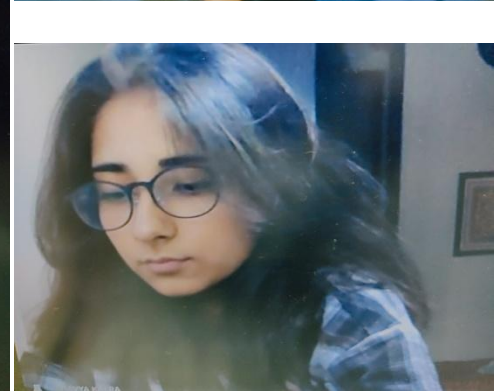


St Cecilia's Public School
