PREACHINGS OF GURU NANAK DEV JI

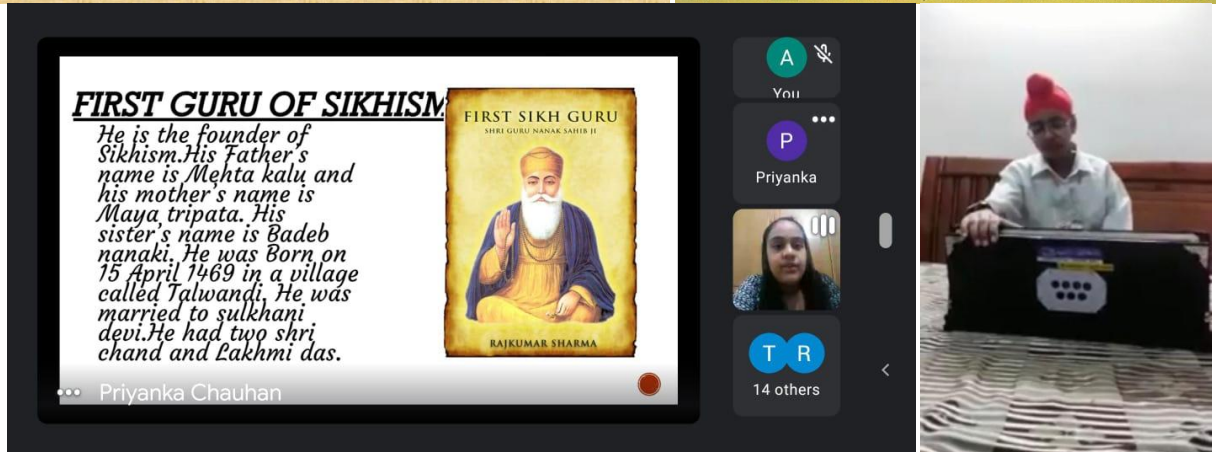
There is One God : To Guru Sahib, Hindus, Muslims, Christians and Sikhs, everybody was the same, yet they all are ignorant to God, he said.

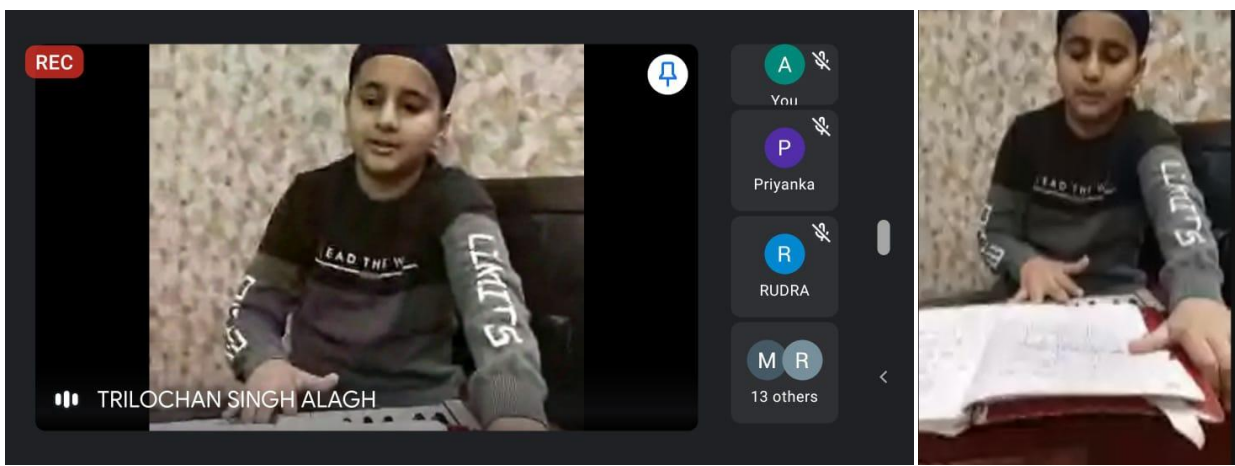
Women are equal to men : According to him, in the eyes of the Supreme God, we all (men or women) all are his children.
