Topic	Vigilance against Cyber frauds



A workshop on **Vigilance Against Cyber Frauds** was conducted in school for the students of Classes **VI to XII** with the objective of creating awareness about safe digital practices. The session aimed to educate students about the growing cases of online frauds and the importance of being alert while using the internet.

IT Club members explained various types of cyber frauds such as **phishing emails, OTP scams, UPI frauds, fake links, identity theft, and social media impersonation**. Students were taught how cybercriminals trick users into sharing personal information and financial details. Real-life examples were described to help students understand how easily one can fall prey to online scams.

The workshop also highlighted important safety measures, including using **strong passwords**, avoiding unknown links, enabling **two-factor authentication**, keeping devices updated, not sharing **OTP or bank details**, and reporting suspicious activities immediately. Students were advised to stay vigilant while using social media and digital payment apps.

The students were also informed about Cyber safety helpline number and website. Overall, the workshop proved to be highly informative and helped students become more aware, responsible, and cautious digital citizens.
