**Activity:** Important Monuments of India & Major Soil types of India  
**Date:** 20 January 2026 and 22 January 2026



The Quiz Club continued its series of engaging map activities with two exciting sessions in January.

The first session focused on Important Monuments and their Locations. Students of Classes VI-VIII enthusiastically marked and identified monuments like the Taj Mahal (Uttar Pradesh), Red Fort (Delhi), and Hampi (Karnataka) on the map of India, connecting history and geography and strengthening their understanding of India's rich cultural diversity and spatial awareness.

The second activity focused on India's Eight Major Soil Types. Students identified and located soils like Alluvial, Black, Red and Laterite on the map, gaining practical knowledge of India's diverse soil landscape and enhancing their understanding of soil characteristics and geographical distribution.

Both activities developed students' map-reading skills, fostered curiosity, and made learning interactive and enjoyable, promoting a deeper connection with India's cultural heritage and natural resources.
