Various Map activities

As part of the Quiz Club activities, various map-based activities were organised during Term II for the students of Grade 10. These activities were designed to help students gain a deeper understanding of the physical and political geography of India.

In Activity 4: Students were asked to locate and label Major iron ore mines, coal mines, Important oil fields, Thermal and Nuclear power plants on the map of India which helped in developing an understanding of the distribution of mineral resources and energy centres in India and their importance in industrial development.

In the month of October, students located and labelled major manufacturing industries of India. It helped students to understand the factors influencing the location of industries and the role of manufacturing and IT sectors in India's economy.

Later in the beginning of November, Activity 6: - Major sea ports and International airports of India was conducted. The objective of this map activity was to help students locate, identify, and understand the distribution of major sea ports and international airports of India and enhance knowledge about India's transport network and its importance in trade and connectivity.

The map work activities in Class 10 provided students with an opportunity to explore India's diverse features. These activities made learning engaging and improved students' analytical and map-handling skills.
